- NEW HOUSES: We have a new house that we have successfully move residents into, welcome everyone at WC! We also have another house, LR that people will be moving into this month.
- NEW RESIDENTS: Since August we have managed to offer 17 new people a room!
- DONATIONS: In the last 2 years we have successfully applied for grants and funds of over £28,000 for individuals. This has gone towards things such as laptops, mobile phones, deposits to move out, furniture, passports, driving licences, and courses.
- MOVE ON'S: Over the last three months we have seen 6 people move on successfully into private rental, housing associations, and university, congratulations to those of you who have moved out! One of our residents has made an amazing achievement by gaining employment as PCSO and will be moving out very soon!
