



BACK TO WORK SCHEME:


Please make sure you inform us when you secure full or part time employment, so that your benefits are not ceased immediately, you may be given the transitional period you need without losing your housing benefit. You must submit employment details together with pay slips. This information will ensure that Housing Benefit is continued during the transitional period and that you are not putting your accommodation at risk.

MOVING ON:

Are you ready to move on and into your own private rental accommodation? Ask about the Safe Haven Sussex move on scheme. You may be eligible for an interest free loan provided by Safe Haven Sussex; we will also pay the £250.00 administration fee for you.
